

Dunweedin' for children's playareas

Each year in the UK over 150,000 children are treated in hospital for injuries received from accidents involving playground equipment, most of which are as a result of falls from the equipment to the ground.

Of all types of loose play surfaces Dunweedin' rubber chippings have proved to be a far superior alternative as the graph here shows.

A 6 inch (150 mm) depth of Dunweedin is equivalent to 12 inches (300 mm) of woodchip for impact absorption and gives protection for falls of over 10 feet (3 metres)
